On the arm where you got the shot:

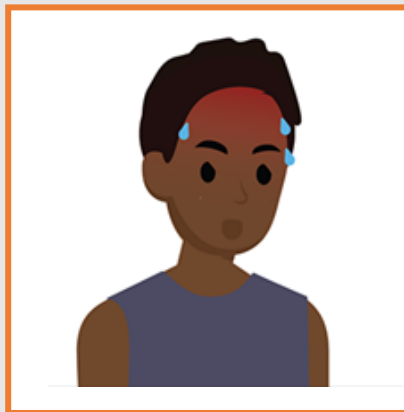
Throughout the rest of your body:

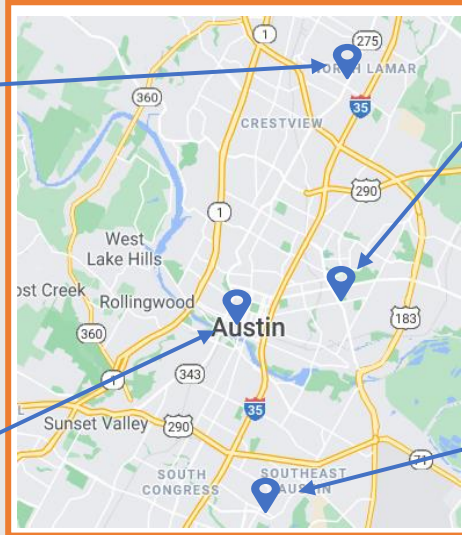
