ECHO	Anyone in Austin/Travis County that is experiencing HUD’s definition of Category 1 “Literally Homeless” and or Category 4: “Fleeing Domestic Violence “	Monday-Friday over the phone.	Austin ECHO website: https://www.austinecho.org/get-help/experiencing-homelessness/
Community Care Clinic *ARCH & Care Connections location	Individuals experiencing homelessness and a patient of CommunityCare	Monday-Friday	Ask your Community Care provider during your appointment or if you have been referred for their case management services
Community Health Paramedics	Frequent users of Austin-Travis County EMS services. Patients that are vulnerable or at risk of deteriorating.	Monday-Friday	As needed for those receiving services
Downtown Community Court (DACC)	Individuals experiencing homelessness and have received at least one ticket in the downtown area.	Monday-Friday 8am-4pm	If you have been assigned to a DACC case manager, please ask to schedule a CA. If you don’t have a DACC case manager, you can request to be added to the waitlist.

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The Charlie Center (Formerly known as Mosaic Street Outreach Ministry)	Street Outreach	Typically, Monday-Friday	As needed for those receiving services
The Other Ones	Individuals working with WFF, Esperanza Community residents, & clients enrolled in Esperanza case management	Monday- Friday	As needed for those receiving services
SAFE Alliance	Survivors of domestic violence, sexual violence, human trafficking, and child abuse	Monday-Friday	Contact SAFEline for a referral to a confidential CA screening. Established SAFE clients may be referred directly to CA by their service provider.
