

Resources for Social Security Benefits

SOAR (SSI/SSDI, Outreach, Access, & Recovery) is a model used to assist individuals experiencing homelessness or at-risk of homelessness apply for social security benefits.

There are limited SOAR Representatives to assist all the individuals who might benefit.

There are other options besides SOAR to apply for benefits.

Yes, using the SOAR model has a higher approval rate based on the five critical components SOAR Representatives use on claims.
